



## **Cybersecurity Awareness Training**

## Cybersecurity awareness basics:

- Enforce the use of strong passwords and avoid reusing them.
- Implement multi-factor authentication (MFA or 2FA).
- Avoid using poorly secured public Wi-Fi.
- Install security software on all devices.
- Train employees to access sensitive data only from company devices and via a VPN (encrypted) connection.

## Why is training important?

Many cyber attacks, especially ransomware, rely on human error.

- Skilled cybercriminals can easily forge convincing emails that appear to come from clients, managers, or suppliers.
- It's easy to inadvertently click on a malicious link in a phishing email.
- Resulting cyber incidents can lead to extortion (ransom), business interruption, compromised data, and more.

## **How to Activate Your Training**

Setting up your Wizer training programme is simple and straightforward. Follow these three steps to enable your Wizer training from the Cowbell Platform:

- 1 Log into the Cowbell Platform.
